Independent Auditor's Review Report on the Quarterly and Year to Date Unaudited Standalone Financial Results of NCC Limited, pursuant to the Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended

Review Report to The Board of Directors **NCC** Limited

- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying statement of unaudited standalone financial results of NCC Limited (the "Company") which includes 4 branches and 40 Joint Operations for the quarter and six month period ended September 30, 2024 (the "Statement") attached herewith, being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations").
- The Company's Management is responsible for the preparation of the Statement in accordance 2. with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34, (Ind AS 34) "Interim Financial Reporting" prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 as amended, read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations. The Statement has been approved by the Company's Board of Directors. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
- We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review 3. Engagements (SRE) 2410, "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity" issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. This standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the Statement is free of material misstatement. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

We also performed procedures in accordance with the Master Circular issued by the SEBI under Regulation 33(8) of the Listing Regulations, to the extent applicable.

Based on our review conducted and procedures performed as stated in paragraph 3 above and 4. based on the consideration of the review reports of other auditors of the branch referred to in paragraph 5 below, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standards ('Ind AS') specified under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 as amended, read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of the Listing Regulations, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.

 - 1 branch whose unaudited interim financial results and other financial information reflect total assets of Rs. 37.40 crores as at September 30, 2024, total revenues of Rs 7.79 crores and Rs. 12.33 crores, total net profit after tax of Rs. 0.62 crores and Rs. 1.01 crores, and total comprehensive income of Rs. 0.62 crores and Rs. 1.01 crores for the quarter and six month period ended September 30, 2024, and net cash outflows of Rs. 0.16 crores for the six month period ended September 30, 2024, as considered in the Statement which has been reviewed by their branch auditor.

The independent auditor's report on interim financial results and other financial information of this branch has been furnished to us by the Management and our conclusion on the Statement, in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of this branch, is based solely on the report of such branch auditor and procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 3 above.

This branch is located outside India whose financial results and other financial information have been prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in their respective country and which have been reviewed by other auditor under generally accepted auditing standards applicable in their respective country. The Company's management has converted the financial results of such branch located outside India from accounting principles generally accepted in their respective country to accounting principles generally accepted in India. We have reviewed these conversion adjustments made by the Company's management. Our conclusion in so far as it relates to the balances and affairs of such branch located outside India is based on the report of other auditor and the conversion adjustments prepared by the management of the Company and reviewed by us.

Our conclusion on the Statement in respect of matters stated in para 5 above is not modified with respect to our reliance on the work done and the report of the other auditors and the financial results certified by the Management.

- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of unaudited consolidated financial results of NCC Limited (the "Holding Company") which includes 4 branches, 40 joint operations and its subsidiaries (the Holding Company and its subsidiaries together referred to as the "Group") and its associates for the quarter and six month period ended September 30, 2024 (the "Statement") attached herewith, being submitted by the Holding Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended (the "Listing Regulations").
- 2.
