






Key Ratios – Half Yearly




The Indian VFX segment grew 10%


- International strikes disrupted TV and film production, impacting Indian VFX studios.
- Indian VFX studios adapted by seeking domestic collaborations and exploring alternative international markets.
- OTT platforms like Disney+ and Netflix reduced entertainment content spending in response to market dynamics.
- Domestic market for VFX in mid-sized Indian films saw increased uptake, boosting domestic revenue.
- Major Indian film productions allocated significant budgets for VFX, comprising 25% to 30% of total project costs.
- VFX studios experienced a rise in revenue from commercial projects due to increased CGI usage in advertisements.
- Advancements in Al and machine learning enhanced VFX workflows, enabling instant visualization and task automation.
- Adoption of virtual production in India lagged behind developed markets, hindered by integration challenges and skill gaps.
- Virtual production studios primarily served local producers, with limited engagement from international clients.
- Challenges included the need for skilled artists and substantial investments in asset development for virtual production.


