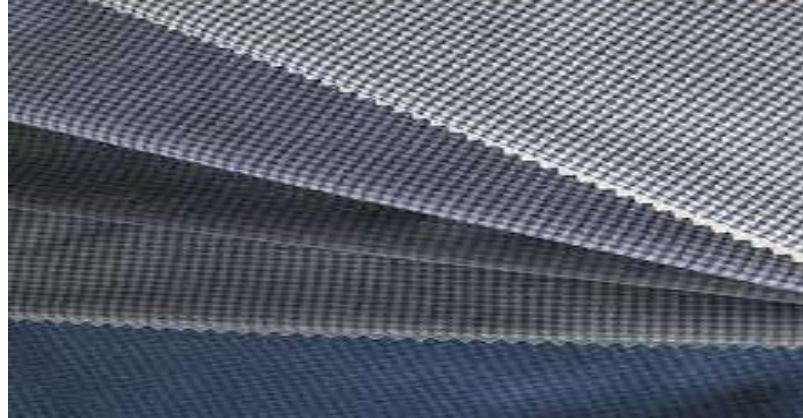

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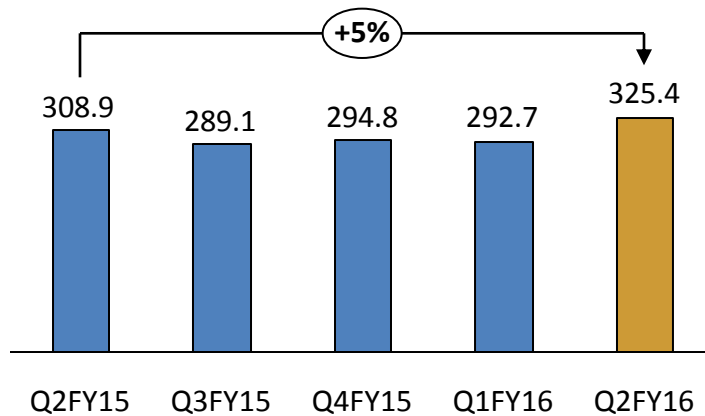

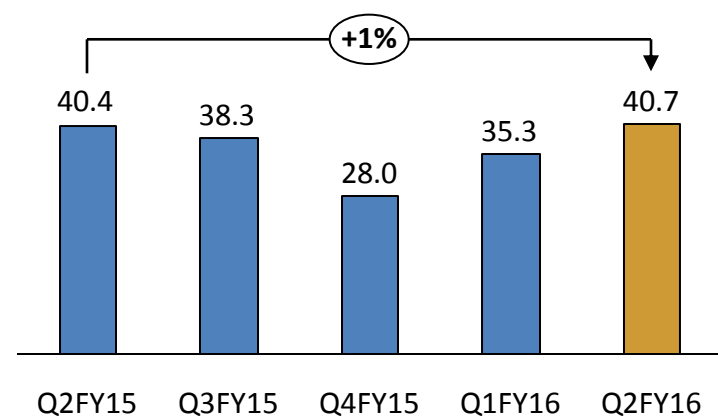
Strong Sequential Recovery Underway - Consolidated



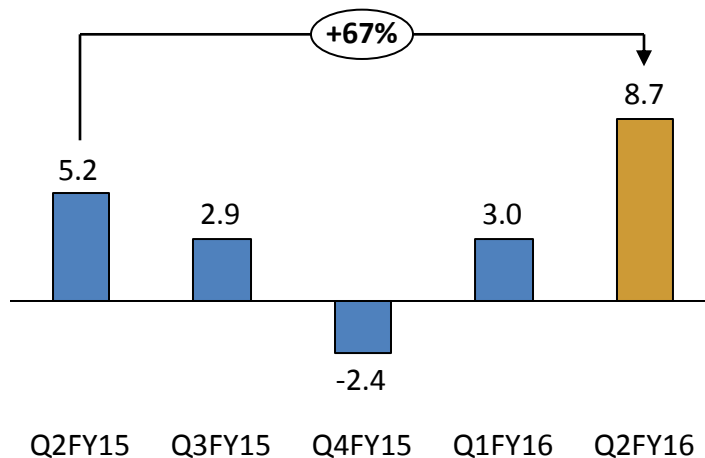
Revenue Rs crs



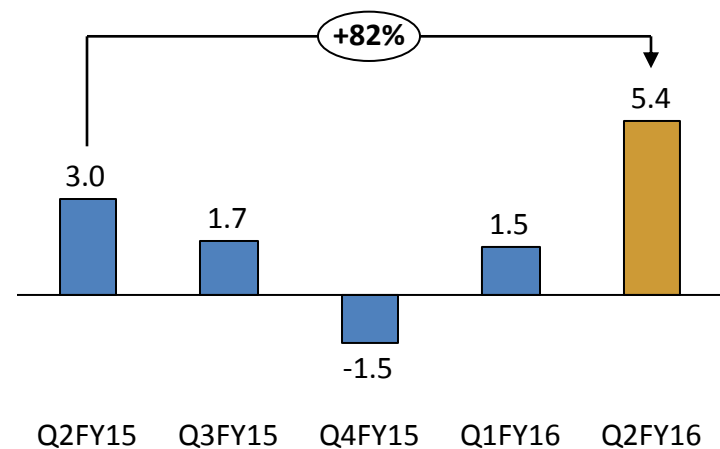
EBIDTA Rs crs

Q2 FY16 Results Highlights

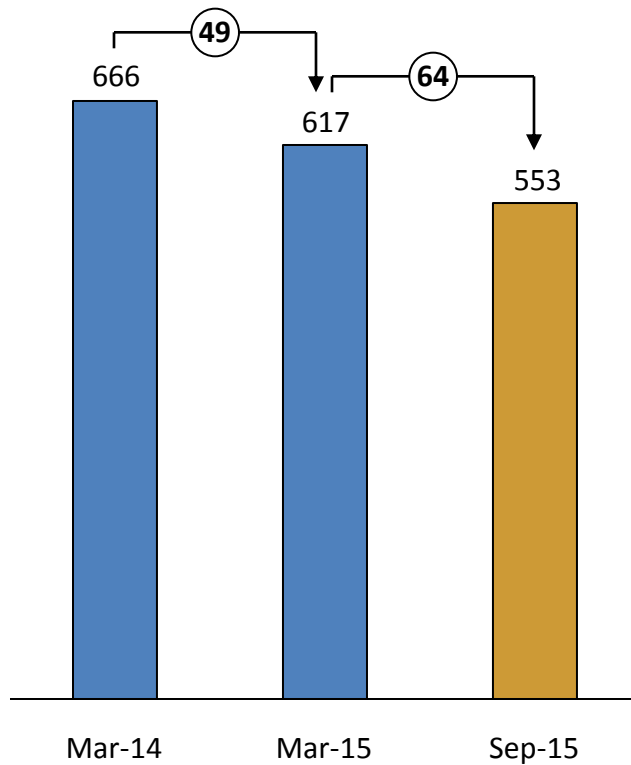


- ▶ Revenue growth of 1% to Rs. 325 crores
 - Revenues loss form Coach logo business and dissolving of Carreman JV impacting sales
- ▶ Better realisations from Garmenting and Fabrics business led to improvements in Gross Margins
- ▶ EBITDA grew by 8% to Rs. 40.7 crores
 - EBITDA margin expanded by 80bps to 12.5%
- ▶ Finance expense lower by 8% to Rs. 19 crores
 - Net Debt reduction of Rs. 64 crores to Rs. 553 crores
- ▶ PAT grew by 83% to Rs. 5.4 crores
- ▶ Focus on retail Garmenting and Fabric to future drive growth
- ▶ Good initial break thorough in market like Japan which can be leveraged going forward using Banswara's Product Differentiation and Cost Innovation Strategy
- ▶ Company has made additional investment worth of Rs. 1 crore during the quarter in Treves Banswara Private Ltd. And now the total investment is Rs. 3.6 crore

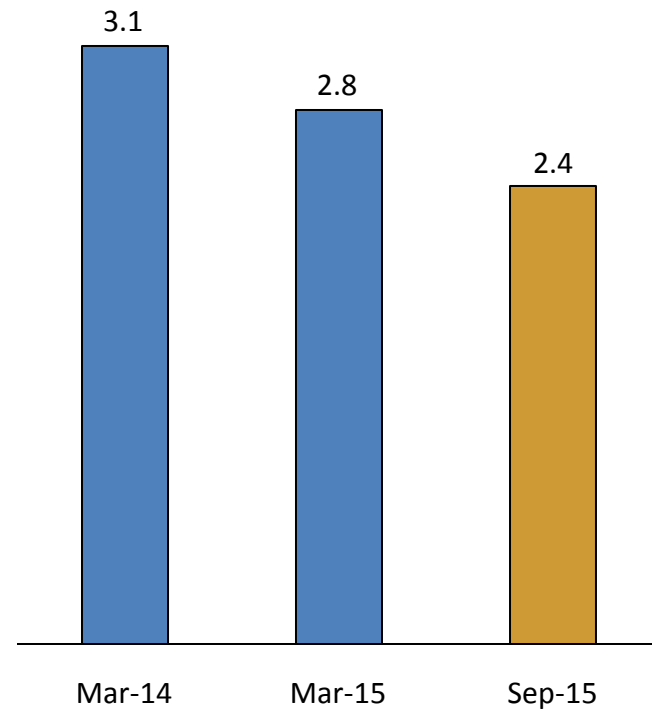
Debt Repayment on Schedule

 - P/V Dyed Yarn - Rigid and Lycra, 100% Acrylic Yarn, Worsted Yarn with blends like P/W and P/W/Lycra

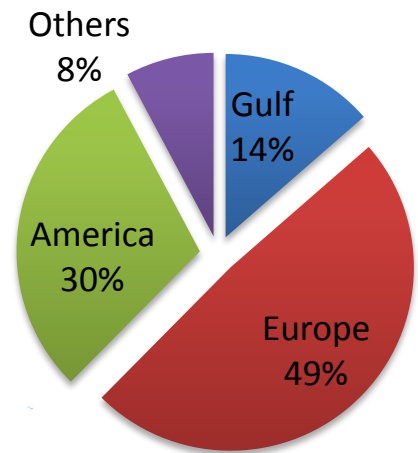

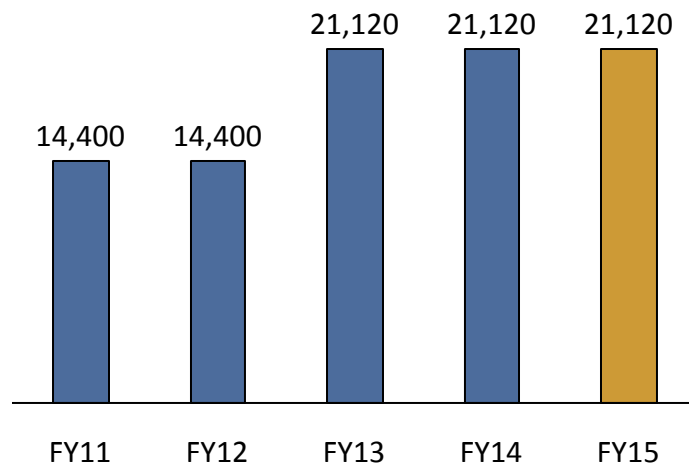

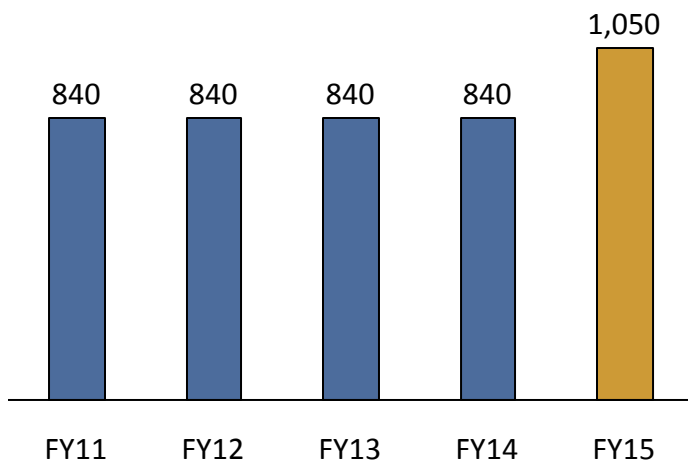

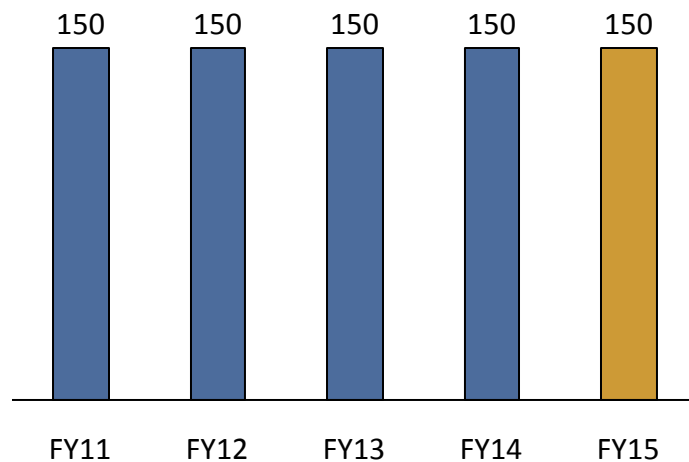

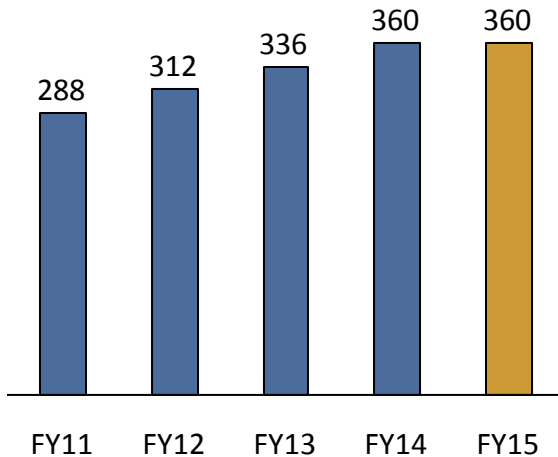

Capacity in Lac Mtrs/Year

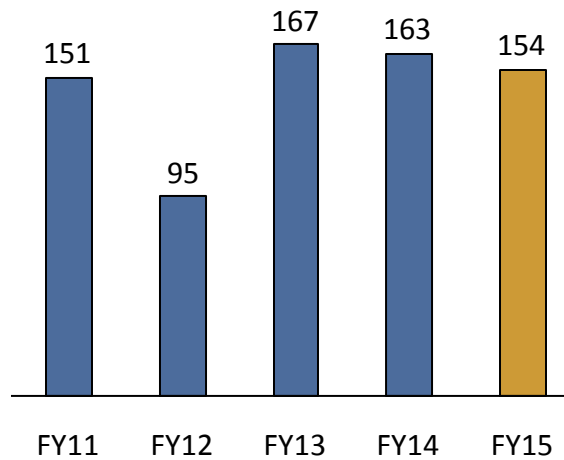

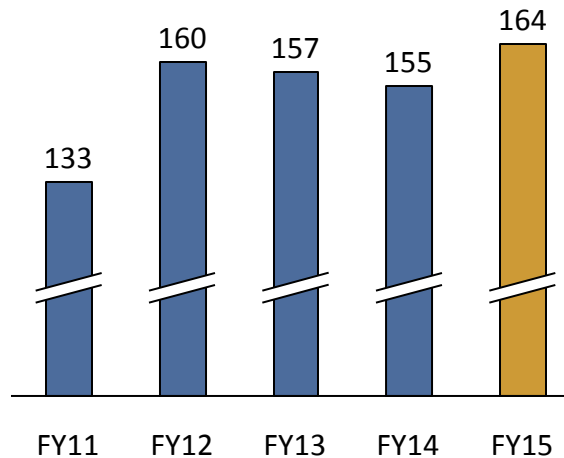

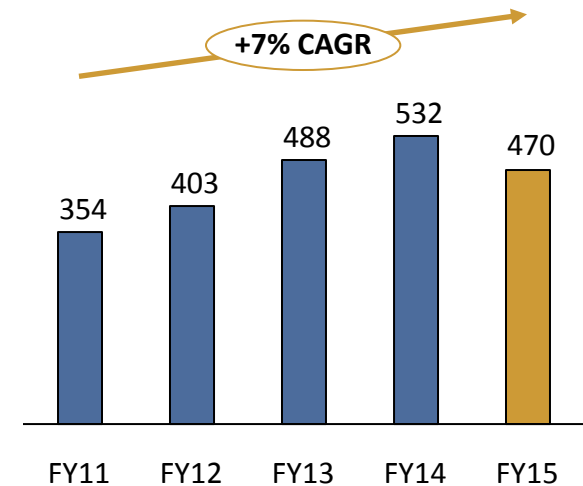

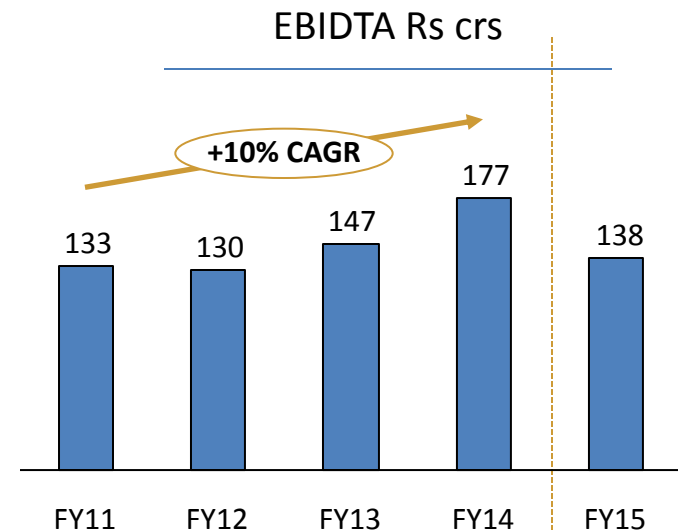

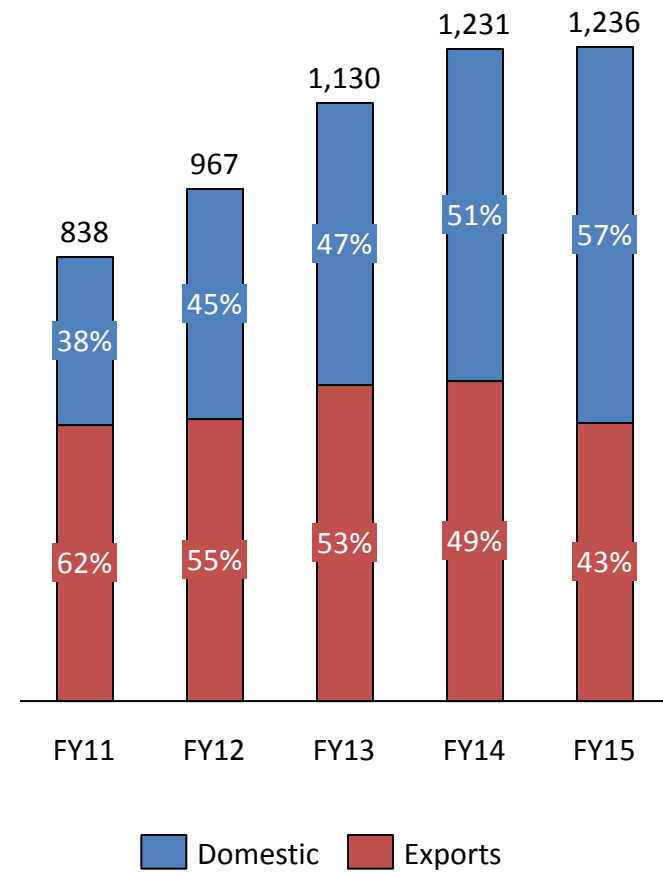
Standalone Revenue Performance
