Highlights – Q2/H1 FY26

- Q2FY26 Total Income stable at ₹131.86 crores
- Profit After Tax for Q2FY26 at ₹88.14 crores (86% growth y-o-y; driven by legacy issue resolution)
- Significant improvement in asset quality; Net Stage III at ₹47 crores in Q2FY26
- Loan Sanctions and Disbursement at ₹1,048 crores and ₹326 crores respectively in Q2FY26

- Q2FY26 PAT at ₹88.14 crores compared to ₹47.34 crores in Q2FY25
- Q2FY26 disbursement at ₹326 crores compared to NIL in Q2FY25
