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
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



Overview - Sector

- India's sugar production for SS 16-17 was 20.30 million tonnes and expected production for the SS 17-18 is around 26 million tonnes
- Consumption estimated at 25 million tonnes during 2017-18
- FRP declared at Rs 2550/tonne of sugarcane linked to sugar recovery of 9.5% for ensuing sugar season.
- An increase of RS 10/quintal announced in SAP for U.P. for sugar season 2017-18
- Domestic sugar realizations are now hovering around ₹31500 per tonne (ex-mill).
- Ethanol Price fixed at ₹ 40.85 per litre for 2017-18

Financial Performance

- The Revenue of the company grew by 9.5% to Rs 778.10 crores during Q3FY18 vis a vis Q3 FY 17
- PBT stood at Rs 84.15 crores Q3FY18 as compared to Rs 91.15 crores during Q3 FY17
- PAT stood at Rs 64.26 crores during Q3FY18 against Rs 52.85 crores during Q3 FY17
- EPS stood at Rs 9.68/share for Q3FY18 as against at Rs 7.96/share for Q3FY17

- Company raised CP of Rs 50 crores during the quarter.
- The Company repaid long term loans of Rs 16.64 crores during Q3FY 18
- Long Term Loans stood at Rs 516.12 crores as on 31st December 17.
- Working Capital facilities as on 31st December 17 stood at Rs 572.75 Crores (Sugar Stocks -157900 Tonnes)
- Average cost of Long Term Debt stood at 8.31%
- Long Term Debt-Equity ratio at 0.47
